Full sun/part shade



Height 4m



Spread 2.5m



Space 1m apart

## Features:

- Outstanding medium growing Lillypilly
- Large, glossy leaves
- New growth is one of the darkest crimson foliage available
- White flowers borne over summer are followed by edible berries
- Berries attracts native birds
- Hardy, frost and dry tolerant
- Responds well to shaping

## Suggested Uses:

- Screening or hedging
- Topiary specimen in gardens or large tubs
- Low water gardens
- Low maintenance areas
- Small gardens
- Native gardens
- General garden use
- Coastal regions

## Water Requirements:

Low. Once established, quite dry tolerant requiring only an occasional long soak during extended periods of heat.

## Care:

Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. Prune to shape during early spring to encourage dense habit. Use a fertiliser formulated for natives according to manufacturers directions.
