For a formal garden as a smart alternative to box, this compact native shrub is ideal. Use it as a low hedge, especially in harsh coastal areas or beside a pool. It's non-flowering and suits narrow spaces. pma.com.au

☀️ Full sun ↑1.5m ↔1m

This Grandiflora rose produces lots of long-stemmed, fragrant blooms, gold centres and cerise outer petals. It thrives in heat and sun, and has great disease resistance. swanes.com.au



'Melbourne Town'

☀️ Full sun ↑1.5m ↔1m

This rose has won many awards for the quality of its flower, and its health and vigour. It's a classic Hybrid Tea with fragrant, salmon-pink flowers, which are great for the garden or picking. Growing at Ross Roses, breeders in Adelaide, it has come through the last extremely hot summer well. The flower colour hasn't faded and the foliage has proven sun-hardy. rossroses.com.au
