# 'RING A DING DING'

WINTER COLOUR



Winter is often quite flat in the garden but with *Correa* 'Ring a Ding Ding' those days are over. 'Ring a Ding Ding' forms a low, branching yet compact evergreen small shrub that literally drips with deep orange blossoms from late autumn right through to spring. These delightfully bell-shaped blooms will not only attract birds to your winter garden but also much admiration as either a striking container plant, an informal hedge or within a mixed border.

Feed with a fertiliser formulated for natives during autumn. Can be pruned to shape if required.
