Full Sun/Part Shade

Height 30cm

Spread 40cm

Features:

- · Classic white flowers
- Exquisite fragrance
- · Compact and free flowering
- Will repeat bloom if spent flower heads removed
- · Heavy flowering in spring

Suggested Uses:

- Container for lengthy colour
- Small gardens, patios and courtyards
- Fragrance for entertainment areas entrances
- Ideal for low edging around garden beds or paving
- Mass plant as ground cover

Water Requirements:

Low. Once established, quite dry tolerant requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat.

Care:

Low maintenance and easy to grow. Apply a slow release fertiliser during early spring. No pruning generally required although removing spent flower stems will encourage further flushes.
