**Species:** *Dianella tasmanica*

### Features:

- Striking new pink foliage maturing to a unique yellow and lime variegation
- Strong, upright habit
- Display of brilliant cobalt blue berries after flowering
- Extremely hardy and dry tolerant for difficult landscaping sites

### Suggested Uses:

- Mass plant for low maintenance areas in residential, commercial or public landscaping projects
- Small gardens and/or narrow spaces
- Dry/gravel style gardens or xeriscaping
- Native or bushland style designs
- Year round interest from foliage ideal for structure in perennial borders
- Great for coastal regions
- Can be grown in large containers for paved areas

### Water Requirements:

Low. Once established, very dry tolerant requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat.

### Care:

Plant in most soil types. Requires good drainage if receiving regular irrigation or in areas of high rainfall. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser formulated for natives. Pruning generally not required other than removing spent flower stems to tidy if preferred. No known pests or diseases.
