## Features:

- Long grey-green foliage with new growth tinged pink-red
- Spikes of golden lime yellow coloured flowers  
smother foliage from late winter through spring
- Compact growth habit
- Tolerant of hot, dry conditions

## Suggested Uses:

- Stunning container displays
- Water wise and Mediterranean style gardens
- Coastal gardens
- Dry or gravel style gardens or xeriscaping
- Year round interest and structure

## Water Requirements:

Dry tolerant once established, requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat

## Care:

Plant in most soil types that are well draining. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser according to manufacturer's directions. Remove spent flower heads to encourage further flushes. If pruning, take care to avoid contact with sap.
