Features:

- Large, well displayed mauve pink cone flowers
- Long lasting as cut flower
- Ornamental, dark green foliage
- Flowering from spring into summer
- Very hardy, drought tolerant, low water user
- Easy to grow with minimal maintenance
- Frost Hardy

Suggested Uses:

- Difficult sites such as coastal plantings, road sides, parks and other public spaces
- Ideal for both native or exotic style gardens
- Can be grown in larger containers or tubs
- Informal hedging
- General garden use
- Great for coastal regions

Water Requirements:

Low. Once established in a part shade location it is reasonably dry tolerant requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat.

Care:

Hardy in most well drained, neutral to acid soils and requires an open sunny position. If grown in containers best to use a low phosphorus mix. Plants should be pruned after flowering to remove old flower heads and to encourage fresh, new growth. Feed in early spring with a slow release fertiliser for natives as per instructions in order to maximise results.
