The unusual structure and striking foliage of Euphorbias make them an eye-catching addition to any garden. This is a low maintenance, hardy and dry tolerant variety, which creates interest in any landscape.

CARE

Dry tolerant once established, requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat.

Plant in most soil types that are well draining. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser according to manufacturer's directions. Remove spent flower heads to encourage further flushes.
