

Viburnums are versatile evergreen shrubs which can be used as specimens, hedges or screening plants throughout the garden. They have been grown extensively with great success in Australian gardens for decades. Viburnum 'Anvi' produces extra large flowers (12cm across), which completely cover the bush in winter through to late spring. The flowers are followed by deep, purplish-blue berries and both are ideal for use in floral arrangements. The stems of the new growth of 'Anvi' also flush a crimson colour, adding contrast to the forest green foliage. Viburnum 'Anvi' will grow to an evergreen, dense, round, compact shrub of dark green, shiny foli<u>age.</u>

Low-medium. Grow in a moisture retentive soil for optimum results. Prune to required shape or size after berries are finished.
