Water Requirements:

Low. Quite dry tolerant once established, only requiring an occasional deep watering during periods of extended heat.

Care:

Plant in most soil types that are well draining. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser formulated for natives for best results. Support the plant with a stake until established.
