'Renga Renga Lily' or 'New Zealand Rock Lily'

DRY SHADY AREAS

Species: *Arthropodium cirratum*



Full shade



Height 40cm



Spread 50cm

Features:

- Ideal for dry shady areas
- Ideal plant for under the base of trees
- Mass planting for stunning effect

Suggested Uses:

- Lush backdrop for water features and garden ornaments in shaded areas
- Edging, borders and along retaining walls
- Low maintenance and difficult shady areas

Water Requirements:

Low. Very dry tolerant once established, requiring only an occasional deep soak during periods of extended heat.

Care:

Feed in spring with a general fertiliser and remove flower stems as they fade to encourage more to develop. Protect from frosts and snails. Mulching advisable.
