### LONG FLOWERING

**Origin:** Victoria, Australia

**Species:** *Salvia buchananii* hybrid

**Protection Status:** PBR protected

### Features:

- Large, bright coral flowers right throughout the warmer months
- Tubular flower capped with a colourful pink calyx which remains some time after flowering extending interest even longer
- Mid-green foliage is dense and lush
- Fast growing

### Suggested Uses:

- Mass plant in drifts for stunning, low maintenance displays
- Large containers
- Mixed borders
- General garden use

### Water Requirements:

Dry tolerant once established. Requires an occasional long soak during extended periods of heat.

### Care:

Grows well in most soil types but thrives in fertile, well drained soils. Trim off around one third of size after flowering to maintain shape and encourage a dense, bushy habit. An application of slow release fertiliser in spring will be beneficial.
